

GATE FEES APPLY TO ALL EXHIBITORS - STRICTLY NO TICKET NO ENTRY

PLEASE READ SCHEDULE CAREFULLY AS CONDITIONS HAVE CHANGED. The Show is conducted under the Rules and Regulations of the Sunshine Coast Show Society Incorporated and the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies

- 1. Entries must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor.
- 2. Exhibits must not show any Producer Identification.
- 3. Entry forms must reach the Show Office by 4 p.m. Wednesday 11th June 2025
- 4. Class tickets will be available at the Show Office at the Showgrounds once entries have been lodged online or delivered to the Show Office. Class Tickets must be attached to all exhibits.
- 5. Entries are to be delivered to the Main Pavilion, close to the main entrance on Thursday 12th June between 8.00 am and 1.00 pm providing entry forms have been lodged. Exhibits will be judged on Friday 13th June 2025 from 8.00 am.
- 6. Exhibits to be presented in Egg Cartons.
- 7. Only Show Quality products will be exhibited.
- 8. Eggs will be judged on both external and internal characteristics. Externally, the Judge will be looking for uniformity, texture, colour, freshness and appearance. Internal judging will take yolk, albumen, chalazae, air space and freshness into consideration.
- 9. The Judge will crack open one egg.

- 10. Exhibitors may enter any number of exhibits in each class. All exhibits will be judged but in the event of numerous large exhibits in any one class, display cannot be guaranteed
- 11. UNLESS prior notice is given to the Chief Steward ALL exhibits remain the property of the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show for auction and proceeds to the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show. In the case of special arrangements made with the Chief Steward for exemption of Auction, all produce must be collected after 5.00 pm on Sunday 15th June 2025.
- 12. Exhibitors must present their nomination receipt to collect entries or prizes.
- 13. Exhibitors are not permitted to interfere with the judging process.
- 14. Provisions are made to award 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each class. Judges may withhold any or all places if exhibits are not of an acceptable standard. If there are only three (3) entrants in a Class, only 1st prize will be awarded.
- 15. There is no limit to the number of entries that an exhibitor may enter.;
- 16. Every care will be taken of exhibits but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage;
- 17. All vehicles coming onto the grounds, are subject to and agree to abide by the SCASS traffic management plan. No vehicle entry during Show operating hours.

PRIZE MONEY and PRIZE CERTIFICATES: No prize money will be paid out if there are any outstanding fees. All prize money will be available for collection from the Cashier at the Treasury, located beside the Main Office as soon as possible after 2.00 pm on the Friday of the Show. All prize money is GST-inclusive. Prizes not collected by 30th June 2025 will be forfeited. Prize cards will not be held after June 30th.

DISCLAIMER: The Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show Society (SCASS) shall not be responsible for any accident that may be caused to or by an exhibitor, members of the general public, or competitor and will not, under any circumstances, be responsible for any losses or non-delivery of livestock or entries of any kind, or any injury or damage done thereby. Persons contravening any of SCASS's rules/regulations shall forfeit any prize awarded. SCASS reserves the right to refuse or cancel, or require any entry to be removed at any time. Exhibitors shall accept the decision of the Stewards/Judges appointed by SCASS as final. The decisions of the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show Society Committee are final.
