The Sunshine Coast Show is a ticketed event from Friday to Sunday inclusive.
Access is only via a ticket on these days.

Please read the schedule carefully as conditions have changed.

The Show is conducted under the Rules and Regulations of the Sunshine Coast Show Society Incorporated and the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies.

The Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show Society is celebrating 120 years of Shows.

1. Entries must have been taken by the entrant. **NO AI (Artificial Intelligence) entries will be accepted.**

2. Entries to be entered via ShowDayOnline and close at 4.00 pm on Friday, 5th June 2026.

The Show Office will assist with ShowDay entries up to 2 pm on Friday, June 5th.

3. The ShowDayOnline Program requires:

Entrant's name: Joe Bloggs

Exhibit's name: Happy Pups (Can **not** be the Entrant's name nor a trade name)

4. The ShowDay label must be securely fastened to the FRONT of the print, to facilitate judging. If the Showday label is not on the front of the print, the entry cannot be accepted. Please retain the duplicate ticket with your name on it to obtain your entry upon collection. (See note 11).

5. The entrant's name **must NOT appear on the face of the print.**

The Entrant's Name, Address, Photo Title, and Entry Class are to be printed in block letters on the **BACK** of the entered mount, to facilitate return to the photographer.

6. Entrants outside the Sunshine Coast region may post their class-labelled entries to reach the Society by Tuesday, 2nd June 2026. Please enclose a sufficiently post-stamped, self-addressed envelope/packet for return of photographs after the Show, address to: Photography Steward, Sunshine Coast Show, P.O. Box 491, Nambour, 4560

7. When handing entries into the show office, all entries are to be in a ziplock/plastic bag with the name printed clearly on the bag. Entries can also be dropped into Camera House, shop 10/45-49 Plaza Parade, Maroochydore.

8. Any prize-winning photographs exhibited in any previous Sunshine Coast Shows are not eligible for entry.

9. Print sizes will be limited to 5 X 7", 8 X 10", and 10 X 12" OR A4. Entries must have a mat to enable ShowDay entry labels to go on the front. Sponsor Camera House Maroochydore will sell the appropriately sized mat to entrants and print your entry from a digital file at no extra charge. Alternatively, entrants may print their entries and mount them on card, foam board, or a mat.

10. Framed and Glass-Mounted Prints will **NOT** be accepted.

11. Exhibits may be collected on Sunday after 5 pm, or from Monday, 15th, after 8 am, or by arrangement with the Head Steward or Pavilion Steward. Unless prior arrangements have been made with the Head Steward, any photographs left after June 30th will be disposed of.

Please note ticketed event days.

12. Entrants are not permitted to interfere with the judging process.

13. Provisions are made for awarding 1st, 2nd & 3rd place in each class. Judges may withhold any or all places if exhibits are not of an acceptable standard.

14. Entrants may submit any number of entries.

15. The Society reserves the right to exclude any exhibit that does not comply with the above conditions from judging or displaying.

16. Every care will be taken of entries, but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage.

17. Prize Money/Vouchers may be collected from the Treasury upon presentation of your nomination card. All prize money is GST-inclusive.

18. All vehicles coming onto the grounds agree to abide by the SCASS traffic management plan - no vehicle entry during Show operating hours.

PRIZE MONEY and PRIZE CERTIFICATES: No prize money will be paid out if there are any outstanding fees. All prize money will be available for collection from the Cashier at the Treasury, located beside the Main Office, as soon as possible after 2.00 pm on the Friday of the Show. All prize money is GST-inclusive. Prizes not collected by 30th June 2026 will be forfeited. Prize cards will not be held after June 30th.
