PLEASE READ THE COMPETITION CONDITIONS CAREFULLY:-

The Show is conducted under the Rules and Regulations of the Sunshine Coast Show Society Incorporated and the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies

1. Entries must be the bona fide property of the entrant.
2. Entry forms must reach the Show Office by 4.00 pm on Monday, 8th June 2026.
3. Class Tickets must be attached to all exhibits. Please contact the office or the Fabric Cartel (Shop 3, Ann Street, Nambour) if you require assistance with class tickets by 4:00 pm Friday, June 5th.
4. Entries are to be delivered to the Main Pavilion, close to the main entrance, on Monday, 8th June, between 9:00 am and 6:00 pm. Please follow traffic directional signage. Exhibits will be judged on Wednesday, 10th June. Entries can also be left at the **Fabric Cartel**.
5. Exhibits entered in previous Sunshine Coast Shows are not permitted to be entered into this year's Show.

6. Quality will be the first consideration in judging.
7. Exhibitors may only enter 2 entries in each class. Please ensure that entries are named to distinguish between each item. The ShowDayOnline Program requires:-

Entrant's name: Joe Bloggs

Exhibit's name: Percy Pig or a detail about the item - pink shawl/ blue bonnet etc.

This **can not** be the Entrant's name

All exhibits will be judged. Display can not be guaranteed in the event of too many exhibits in any one class.

8. Exhibits may be collected on Sunday, June 14th, after 5:00 pm. Please note ticketed event days. Remaining entries will be available from the Pavilion on Monday, June 15th, between 7:00 am and 5:00 pm, or by arrangement with the Fabric Cartel. Any remaining items will be held for one week only. All remaining items will be disposed of in accordance with the Rules of the Association.

9. Exhibitors MUST present their nomination receipt to collect entries or prizes.

10. Exhibitors are not permitted to interfere with the judging process.

11. Provisions are made for awarding 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each class. Judges may withhold any or all places if exhibits are not of an acceptable standard. Classes with fewer than three (3) entries will only be awarded a first prize; however, the Association reserves the right to declare 'No Competition' in any class with fewer than 3 entries.

12. Every care will be taken of exhibits, but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage.

13. The Association reserves the right to display only such exhibits as it deems fit and practicable due to infrastructure constraints. If your item does not fit in the available area, your prize card will be displayed.

14. All vehicles coming onto the grounds agree to abide by the SCASS traffic management plan. No vehicle entry during Show operating hours. Please follow road signage and directions.

15. QUILTS:- Rods and Pockets are required on all entries to allow for safe hanging.

16. QUILT NOMINATION FORMS ARE REQUIRED BY 4.00 PM MAY 29th, WITH QUILTS BEING DELIVERED TO THE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE 4:00 PM MONDAY, JUNE 8th, 2026. Quilt entries may be left at Fabric Cartel, Shop 3/20 Ann Street, Nambour - Tuesday to Saturday 9.30 am to 2 pm. For drop off to Fabric Cartel - Mobile 0424 385 990 (Monday to Friday). All other enquiries to the Head Steward.

PRIZE MONEY: No prize money will be paid if any outstanding fees remain. All prize money and vouchers will be available for collection from the Cashier at the Treasury, located beside the Main Office, as soon as possible after 2.00 pm on the Friday of the Show. All prize money is GST-inclusive. Prizes not collected by 30th June 2026 will be forfeited. Prize certificates will not be held past June 30th of that year.
