### **PLEASE READ SCHEDULE CAREFULLY AS CONDITIONS HAVE CHANGED:-**

**The Show is conducted under the Rules and Regulations of the Sunshine Coast Show Society Incorporated and the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies**

1. Entries must be grown by the exhibitor.
2. Exhibits must not show any Grower Identification.
3. Entry forms must reach the Show Office by noon on Thursday, 11th June 2026.
4. Class tickets will be available at the Show Office at the Showgrounds once entries have been lodged online and delivered to the Show Office. Class Tickets must be attached to all exhibits.
5. Entries are to be delivered to the Main Pavilion, close to the main entrance, on Thursday, 11th June, between 8.00 am and 1.00 pm, providing entry forms have been lodged. Exhibits will be judged on Thursday, 11th June 2026, from 2 pm.
6. Exhibits to be presented on biodegradable paper plates. Plates will be provided if needed.
7. Only Show Quality products will be exhibited.
8. Exhibitors are not permitted to sell vegetables on the Showgrounds.
9. Exhibitors may enter a number of exhibits in each class. All exhibits will be

judged but in the event of numerous large exhibits in any one class, display cannot be guaranteed

**10. UNLESS prior notice is given to the Chief Steward ALL exhibits remain the property of the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show for auction and proceeds to the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show. Please arrange with the Chief Steward if you wish to collect your produce and not have it sold at auction. Unauctioned produce must be collected after 5.00 pm on Sunday, 14th June 2026.**

11. Exhibitors must present their nomination receipt to collect entries or prizes.
12. Exhibitors are not permitted to interfere with the judging process.
13. Provisions are made for awarding 1st & 2nd place in each class. Judges may withhold any or all places if exhibits are not of an acceptable standard. If there are only three (3) entrants in a Class, only 1st prize will be awarded.
14. There is no limit to the number of entries that may be made by an exhibitor.
15. Every care will be taken of exhibits, but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage.
16. All vehicles coming onto the grounds are subject to, and agree to abide by the SCASS traffic management plan. No vehicle entry during Show operating hours.

**PRIZE MONEY and PRIZE CERTIFICATES:** No prize money will be paid out if there are any outstanding fees. All prize money will be available for collection from the Cashier at the Treasury, located beside the Main Office as soon as possible after 2.00 pm on the Friday of the Show. All prize money is GST-inclusive. Prizes not collected by 30th June 2026 will be forfeited. Prize cards will not be held after June 30th.

**DISCLAIMER:** The Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show Society (SCASS) shall not be responsible for any accident that may be caused to or by an exhibitor, members of the general public, or competitor and will not, under any circumstances, be responsible for any losses or non-delivery of livestock or entries of any kind, or any injury or damage done thereby. Herbs to be presented in small jars of water to prevent wilting. For transport, wrap in a wet paper towel and place in a plastic bag. Place in a jar and add water at the Main Pavilion.
