THIS EVENT IS ONLY OPEN TO CURRENT FINANCIAL MEMBERS OF THE HOBBY HORSE RIDERS ASSOCIATION AND RUN IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE HOBBY HORSE RIDERS ASSOCIATION.

- 1. SHOW ENTRY/EXIT INFORMATION: There is limited parking available on the showgrounds. Paid parking is available at Crusher Park. Drivers need to co-operate with Parking Stewards for the best parking arrangements and maximum safety for horses, riders and public. All vehicles coming onto the grounds agree to abide by the SCASS traffic management plan.
- 2. NOMINATIONS All entries to be entered online at www.sunshinecoastshow.com.au.

 There will be NO REFUNDS after nominations have closed except via email request to show manager for an injured rider. Must be accompanied with a Doctor's Certificate. If a refund has been approved by the committee, payment will be paid within four (4) weeks after the Show.

 Refunds will not be available if you choose to change classes after nominations have closed.
