PLEASE READ SCHEDULE CAREFULLY:-

The Show is conducted under the Rules and Regulations of the Sunshine Coast Show Society Incorporated and the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies.

- 1. Entries must have been taken by the entrant.
- 2. Entries to be entered via ShowDayOnline and close at 4.00 pm on Friday 6th June 2025. The Show Office will assist with ShowDay entries up to 2 pm on Friday June 6th.
- 3. The ShowDayOnline Program requires

Entrant's name: Joe Bloggs

Exhibit's name: Percy Pig (This can not be the Entrant's name)

- 4. Name and details are to be securely fastened on the back only. If the ShowDay Label is not securely fastened to the back of the photo, the entry will not be accepted. Please retain duplicate ticket to obtain your entry upon collection. (See Condition #12).
- 5. All entries are to be placed in a large zip lock/plastic bag with name printed clearly on the bag.
- 6. Entrants outside the Sunshine Coast region may post their class labelled entries to reach the Society by Wednesday 4th June 2025. Please enclose a sufficiently posted stamped, self-addressed envelope/packet for return of photographs after the Show.

- 7. The entrant's name must **NOT** appear on the face of the print. The Entrant's Name, Address, Photo Title, and Entry Class are to be <u>printed in block letters on the back of the entered mount.</u>
- 8. Any prize-winning photographs exhibited in any previous Sunshine Coast Shows are not eligible for entry.
- 9. Prints minimum size $13 \text{cm} \times 18 \text{cm} (5" \times 7")$ in both the Open and Junior Sections. Maximum size of any prints is to be $40 \text{cm} \times 50 \text{cm} (16" \times 20")$. We recommend traditional print sizes
- 10. Framed and Glass Mounted Prints will **NOT** be accepted.
- 11. Exhibits may be collected from 7.00 am to 5.00 pm, Monday (16th June), or by arrangement with the Head Steward or Pavilion Steward. Unless prior arrangements have been made with the Chief Steward, any photographs left after June 30th will be disposed of. **Please note ticketed event days.**
- 12. Entrants are not permitted to interfere with the judging process.
- 13. Provisions are made for awarding 1st, 2nd & 3rd place in each class. Judges may withhold any or all places if exhibits are not of an acceptable standard.
- 14. There is no limit to the number of entries that may be made by an entrant.
- 15. The Society reserves the right to exclude from judging or display, any exhibit that does not comply with the above conditions.
- 16. Every care will be taken of entries, but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage.
- 17. Prize Money/Vouchers may be collected from the Treasury upon presentation of your nomination card. All prize money is GST-inclusive.
- 18. All vehicles coming onto the grounds, agree to abide by the SCASS traffic management plan no vehicle entry during Show operating hours.
