How to Apply

Before applying, please review all Exhibitor information and the full Terms & Conditions. You must accept these terms as part of your application.

All applications must be completed via our website.

Previous Exhibitors

Please log into your account and complete the application process and double-check locations, as some areas may have changed from last year's event.

New Exhibitors

- ◆ You will need to create an account on our website which will grant you access to your personalised dashboard. From there you can begin your Exhibitor Application process.
- ◆ Only applications completed in FULL, with a paid \$100.00 refundable Bond via the website, will be considered.
- ◆ For site locations around the grounds and costs for sites, please review the map in conjunction with the price guide or alternatively, completing your application online will display your estimated total site costs including any additions.
- ◆ When completing your application you will be required to upload copies of your logo, cover image, gallery, your site display, products, insurance (\$20million) and food licence (if applicable).
- ◆ Sites are not available for single-day bookings - all bookings are for the three (3) days of the Show.
- ◆ The first size requirement is the frontage and second depth e.g. 6x3 (6m frontage and 3m depth). Please ensure that the size you have selected accommodates your entire exhibit. This includes the tow hitch and door opening to access the trailer/van as you will be required to fit this within your booked space.
- ◆ Site fee is for the site only, Exhibitor passes, electricity and parking passes are sold separately to accommodate your needs.
- ◆ There are NO direct water connections available to any sites located on the Upper Ring Road and Mid Ring Road.
- ◆ Completing an application is NOT acceptance of a site. All applications are reviewed, and successful applications will be notified whether successful or not via email by April 30. A tax invoice will be issued to those offered a site.
- ◆ All exhibitors must pay their account in full no later than May 15 to secure their site. If your account is not finalised, your site may be offered to another interested party, and your bond will be retained for administration costs. If you foresee payment issues, please contact us immediately.

Important Reminders

Insurance must be valid for the period of the Show and if the policy uploaded in your application expires a current policy must be provided no later than 14 days prior to the event with a minimum of \$20 million coverage.

Food Licences must be valid for the period of the Show and a copy uploaded with your application. Any new licences after close of trades must be emailed to trades@sunshinecoastshow.com.au 21 days from the event. Please note that food licences are sent to the Sunshine Coast Council.

Quiet Hour

We will be trialling a quiet hour on Sunday from 9:00am - 10:00am for all patrons. We will require all exhibitors to adhere to having no flashing lights and a reduction of all amplified sound / noise / music for this period.

Show Hours

Whilst these are the official opening / closing times, you are free to trade outside these times if you wish.

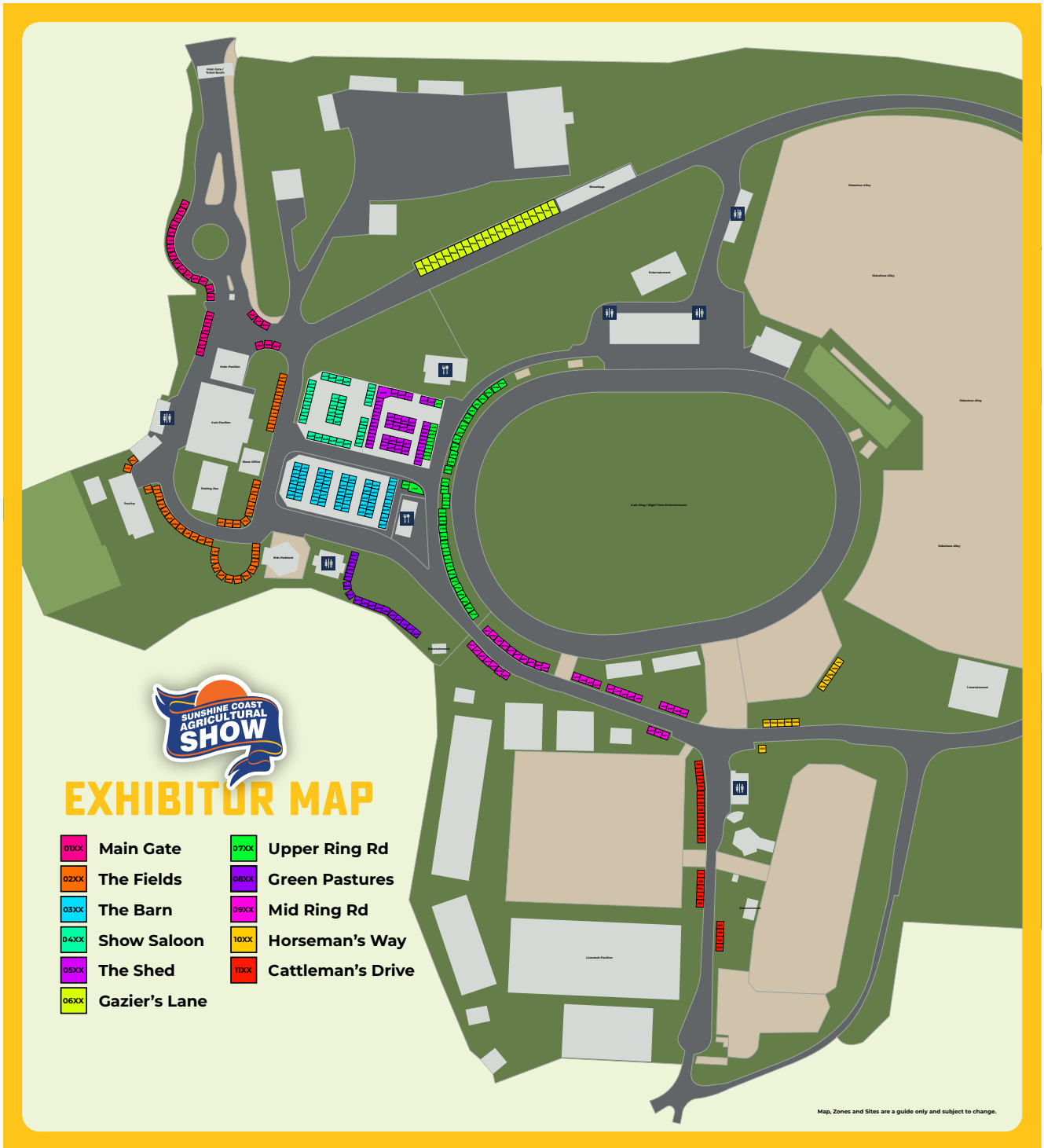

Exhibitor Locations

Each area offers its own unique advantages. Secure your preferred location early - spaces book fast, and premium spots are in high demand.

Main Gate

Make a strong first impression. With 80% of attendees entering through this gate, this location has the highest visibility on the grounds. If you want to promote your business, this is the ideal spot.

The Fields

A versatile grassed area on either side of the Show Office, wrapping its way to the poultry shed. In past years, it has hosted everything from cars, motorbikes, and boats to trucks, machinery, plants, face painters, food, coffee and novelty products. In 2026, it will also feature a free petting zoo, attracting strong family traffic. Note: unlevel in areas..

The Barn

A covered, open-air pavilion located between the Kid's Paddock and Show Saloon. With a steady stream of visitors coming from the Main Gate, The Barn is a bustling hub for diverse businesses - there's truly something for everyone here.

Show Saloon (Food & Licensed Traders Only)

The Show's licensed area features live music, a big screen showing the Main Ring entertainment, and an outdoor grassed terrace. Perfect for breweries, wineries, distillers, and food vendors wanting to trade in a vibrant, social setting.

The Shed

A covered, open-air pavilion located directly opposite the Main Ring, this open-air pavilion enjoys a high flow of people all day and trades later into the night thanks to its location near the Hill, where crowds gather for evening entertainment and fireworks.

Grazier's Lane (Food Vendors Only)

The main hub for food and non-alcoholic beverages only. Located next to the showbag outlets and overlooking the Hill, where families sit to watch the Main Ring and Community Stage. Food vendor numbers are capped to ensure maximum exposure.

Upper Ring Road

One of the highest pedestrian traffic zones, connecting visitors to rides, The Hill, and the Grandstand. Highly sought after. Note: water access is not available in this zone

Green Pastures

A leafy, shaded, family-friendly area with seating and daily entertainment. Ideal for coffee outlets, artisan stalls, boutique food vendors, clothing, and lifestyle exhibitors looking for a relaxed, engaging environment.

Mid Ring Road

A grassy thoroughfare that circles the grounds. With consistent foot traffic, this location provides excellent exposure for trade sites as visitors move throughout the Show.

Horseman's Way

This area links visitors to Sideshow Alley, the Emergency Services Display, and Cattleman's Drive. Perfect for exhibitors wanting to capture energy and flow.

Cattleman's Drive

The secondary entrance into the Show, welcoming patrons straight from a major parking area. This zone is home to the animal and livestock precinct and the Education Stage, making it ideal for businesses wanting to connect with families and rural audiences.

General Information

Power

All leads must have a current 'test and tag' to be on-site, recommended 30 metres leads to reach outlets.

The Show contracted electrician will be available to test & tag (at a cost) prior to the commencement of the Show.

In the interest of public safety, Sunshine Coast Show Society (SCASS) reserves the right to remove any electrical equipment or electrical leads that do not meet 'test & tag' requirements. SCASS will not be liable for any damage to your stock/equipment as a result of electrical equipment or electrical leads not meeting 'test & tag' requirements.

Exhibitors and their contractors need to be aware of underground cables and plumbing. Please check with SCASS management before driving posts into the ground. In some areas, weights can only be used. Any person damaging power cables/plumbing pipes will be liable for the cost of repairs.

Placement of some Exhibits may be governed by power requirements. If your power requirements are not detailed on your application and they exceed what is available in the area, you may incur extra charges for electricity supply or need to be relocated.

All exhibitors must supply their own surge protection equipment and regularly save computer data that may be affected by loss of power.

Recycling/Rubbish

All Exhibitors are required to dispose of all cardboard off-site.

Exhibitors can only use general waste bins allocated to Exhibitors not the general public bins as part of Terms and Conditions.

Ensure your site is kept clean and free of rubbish.

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to remove all grey water and oil. These must be taken off-site and disposed of appropriately.

No oil drums are to be left behind after the event or put in event bins. Demurrage fees will apply.

Water

Direct water connections are available in limited areas.

Placement of some Exhibits may be governed by water requirements. If your water requirements are not detailed on your application, we may not have this available to you.

Security

Security is on the grounds from Wednesday night pre-show until 7:00am Monday post show, along with camera monitoring. While all care is taken, the SCASS accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage of product/s or equipment. If you have any concerns at any time, please report to security guards, Exhibitor Coordinator and/or the Show Office.

Stock delivery

Stock being delivered prior to the event must be arranged through the office to ensure its coordinate arrival time and location. Please note SCASS takes no responsibility for any stock.

Stock delivery at Show time can be delivered to Exhibitors' sites from 6:00am - 8:00am each day of the Show. Any stock deliveries outside these times will need to be walked in.

Refunds and Cancellations

Per our Terms and Conditions:

Bond deposits paid at application will be refunded two (2) weeks post event in the account it was paid from.

SCASS is not obliged to refund bonds to any Exhibitor who breaches the Terms & Condition's at any time over the course of the event and without warning or notice issued.

The Exhibitor acknowledges and agrees, in the event the Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show is cancelled due to government (or other authority) decree, order, or any agency instrumentality, the cancellation fees set out above shall apply.

Allocation of sites

Exhibitors that attended the previous Show need to reapply.

Application for a site does not guarantee your acceptance. Accepted applications will receive an invitation to attend and a tax invoice after April 30.

Site allocation will be the sole direction of the SCASS and can be changed at any time.

SCASS will endeavour to accommodate the needs of all Exhibitors.

Every effort will be made to mark out your site accurately, please contact the Exhibitor Coordinator immediately if there is any confusion with your site boundaries.

Parking

Exhibitor parking needs to be requested on your application.

Parking passes are subject to exhibitor parking availability and parking fees and ticketing fee applies.

Bad Weather

SCASS is an all weather event. We ask you to be prepared for all weather conditions. SCASS shall not be liable for any compensation or refund to exhibitors.

Display Material and Exhibits

Exhibitors are encouraged to make their site look appealing and enticing. Exhibitors are responsible for making sure all materials are secured correctly and safely.

Exhibitors are responsible to have all materials displaying within their allocated site not in walkway or affecting other exhibitors.

SCASS reserves the right to remove any exhibit or item they feel may bring SCASS into disrepute or that is deemed to cause offence.

Dogs

No dogs are allowed on site. Working dogs that are competing or part to show entertainment with approval may be onsite under full supervision/control. Any exhibit that has approval as part of their display, Guide and aid dogs excepted.

Gas Bottles

Gas bottles are not permitted to be used within marquees or tents. All gas bottles must have current LPG certification and are deemed safe for use.

Quiet room/ baby change station

The quiet room is located in the Scout Hall building (please refer to map). This is an air-conditioned quiet space, with baby change facilities.

Passes - Staff & Vehicle

All Exhibitor passes are booked with application and invoiced. Please note: Exhibitor passes are NOT included in your site fee - these are sold separately. Please note as a ticketed event if you don't have a pass you can not enter or will be required to purchase at the gated price.

Extra Exhibitor passes requested after May 30 will need to be purchased via our ticketing platform. Please email trades@sunshinecoastshow.com.au for your link. A ticketing fee will apply.

All Exhibitor parking passes are booked at time of application, once your application has been accepted you will be advised of payment and location method to obtain your parking pass.

Due to the limited Exhibitor parking we will be capping the number of available Exhibitor zoned parking passes.

A vehicle pass will be issued once purchased, this will need to be printed & scanned in at Exhibitor parking, clearly displayed on vehicle once parked.

No passes = No entry.

Please make sure all staff are aware of the condition of the use for these passes and need to display.

If you arrive after 9:00am we can not guarantee parking even with a parking pass.

Public Liability Insurance

All Exhibitors and shared siteholders must hold their own Public Liability Insurance with an indemnity of not less than \$20 million covering them against an occurrence attributable to their activities or the activities of any person for whom they are directly responsible.

Raffles & Competitions

All games of chance and raffles where tickets are sold are not permitted without prior application in writing and approved by SCASS please email: manager@sunshinecoastshow.com.au (Raffles must be registered)

SCASS may in its absolute sole discretion refuse any application.

Removal of goods on-site

All goods used on-site by Exhibitors, must be removed by 1:00pm Monday after the event. Any goods remaining on-site after this are at the Exhibitor risk. Demurrage fees will apply after this at a rate of \$100.00 if the cost to remove or dispose of any goods remaining exceeds this you will be liable for any or costs.

Safety

To comply with the Work Health and Safety Act each Exhibitor is responsible for the creation and maintenance of a safe environment for both their workers and visitors.

Setting up and Dismantling of Sites

Setup of larger sites are available from Wednesday prior to the event with approval from SCASS and registered as early access.

Site setup day is Thursday prior to the Show from 6:00am to 6:00pm. You will be responsible for any persons entering the grounds ensuring they comply with conditions of entry.

Dismantle of site is only to be carried out in your zoned area times for any sites dismantling on the Sunday of the event.

The showgrounds do have a public Wi-Fi connection due to the large volume of demand we can not guarantee coverage.

Trading Terms

By accepting a site at Sunshine Coast Agricultural Show you agree to pay your site fees and any extra charges incurred in full by the due date stipulated on the invoice as per the Trading Terms.

Application of your site does not guarantee you a site – we must receive your application, receive approval and payment in full.

Exhibitors will not be permitted to occupy a site until the payment of site fees has been received in full.

Payments can be made by direct deposit, Cash or Eftpos at the Show Office or Credit Card (Card fee may apply).

All Exhibitors are required to pay a refundable \$100 bond at time of application. If you are unsuccessful in obtaining a site, this bond will be refunded prior to the event. If successful your bond will be held until after the event per T&C's. Payment of this Bond does not guarantee a site. This fee must be paid in full for the application to be considered.

FAQ's

- ◆ Can I buy a 3-day Exhibitor pass and different staff use them on different days?
YES, you can share purchased tickets with other staff for different days.
- ◆ Can I trade longer than minimum trading hours for my area?
YES, you can trade until show gates close, however you are required to trade for the minimum trading hours.
- ◆ Can I bring stock in when the Show is on?
YES, between 6:00am – 8:00am you can bring your vehicle in to re-stock. After 8:00am you will be required to walk stock in, no vehicles are allowed on grounds when the Show is open. We do have golf carts available for assistance in carrying stock if available at the time.
